SCHOLARSHIPS DEADLINES BETWEEN FEB 22 – MAY 31

1) Women's Cyber Security Scholarships - \$6,000 - 10 Awards (Deadline: February 22, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be pursuing, or plan to pursue, a degree with a focus on cybersecurity or information assurance.
- B) Be a senior in high school with a GPA of at least 3.3 on a 4.0 scale.
- C) Be attending full time or part time.
