Credits 50 total credits

Note: 1 credit is earned each semester.

- English – 8 credits
- Math – 6 credits of Algebra or higher curriculum
- Science – 6 credits
- Social Studies – 6 credits
(2 credits Global Studies, 2 credits American Studies, 1 credit Economics, 1 credit Government)
- Physical Education – 2 credits
- Health – 2 credits
- Electives – 12 credits
- Career Education – 1 credit
- Fine & Applied Arts Elective Credits – 6 credits in any one area or combination of areas: Career and Technical Ed classes, The Arts and/or World Language
- Community Service – 1 credit for 100 hours
