## Reading

- Composes a summary of the main idea/theme stating the key points of a text with explicit quotes.
- Distinguishes between literal language and figurative language.
- Identifies basic points of view (1st, 2nd, 3rd) and describe how point of view influences how events are described.
- Compares and contrast two or more characters, ideas, settings, or events in a text using specific details from the text.
- Independently uses reading strategies (re-reading, questioning, connecting, notes, inferences, visualization) to understand difficult and complex text.
- Locates and uses information presented in multiple formats (graphs, pictures, diagrams, charts, media clips) to support an understanding of a text.
- Identifies and explains information presented in varying formats (e.g. graphs, pictures, diagrams, media clips) to understand a text.
- Analyzes the structure of unfamiliar multi-syllabic words by finding compound words, roots, prefixes, suffixes and syllables.
- Recognizes and defines Greek and Latin affixes and roots to break down unknown words.
- Reads grade level text fluently (155-165 correct words per minute) with appropriate expression to support comprehension.

## <u>Writing</u>

- Writes an organized and logical opinion piece with an effective introduction, supporting details/facts, and a logical conclusion that provides closure.
- Selects a topic, gathers information, designs/uses a formatting structure that organizes information, and fits the audience and purpose.
- Applies revision strategies and multiple drafts to strengthen writing.
- Uses words, phrases and sensory details to help the reader understand experiences and events.
- Uses keyboarding skills to produce writing (two pages in a single sitting).
- Chooses credible websites to help develop and publish writing.
- Collaborates with peers, teachers and others to publish writing.
- Summarizes information when taking notes and preparing finished work.
- Composes written responses including textual evidence to strengthen analysis, reflection or research.
- Demonstrates command of: Conjunctions, prepositions, interjections and verb tense.
- Demonstrates command of: Capitalization, spelling grade level words, and punctuation.
