ASHLAND SCHOOL BOARD HOLDS CANDIDATE NIGHT

On Tuesday, March 2, at 7:00 pm the Ashland School Board will host a virtual Open House for individuals who might be interested in running for a position on the school board. Positions #1, #3, and #4 on the school board will be open for the district election to be held May 18, 2021. The session will occur on Zoom:

“People often have questions about what is entailed in serving on the school board,” says current board chair Eva Skuratowicz. “This is a great opportunity to ask the sitting members questions and hear about the commitments expected of directors who sign up for the 4-year terms.”

The board is looking for people interested in doing what is best for students and working collaboratively to help the district achieve its strategic goals of continuous improvement.

Individuals interested in considering one of the positions are encouraged to review the information provided by the [Oregon School Board Association](#). There are resources outlining the role of school boards and information on how to file to become a candidate.

In order to qualify, candidates must live in the boundaries of the school district for at least one year prior to the election. No previous experience is required. The candidate filing process opens February 8 and closes March 18, followed by the election on May 18, 2021, when district voters will decide who will fill the 4-year positions.
