- 1 1" 3-ring binder (hard covered - for Language Arts) with pockets
- 1 a sturdy zippered pencil pouch (with name written on the outside)
- 1 spiral notebooks (Science)
- 2 composition notebooks (Language Arts)
- 2 graph notebooks (Math)
- 1 package of lined paper (about 100 sheets)
- 3 2-pocket folders-paper (not plastic) (2-Science, 1-Language Arts)
- 8 glue sticks - 6 to be collected by the teacher
- 3 packages of pencils - enough to last the whole year (restock as needed)
- 3 handheld pencil sharpeners (they wear out over time - replace as needed)
- 1 high quality eraser or several pencil top erasers
- 2-6 ball point pens (black or blue) - enough to last the whole year (restock as needed)
- 1 set of colored pencils (pre-sharpened - high quality)
- 4 highlighters - (blue and yellow and two other colors)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 water bottle - with name written on it
- 1 box of tissue - to be given to the homeroom teacher
- 6 packs (100 sheets) of 3" x 3" post-it notes (multi-colored)
- 1 package of 4" x 6" lined notecards (Language Arts)

Please note:

Students are expected to come to each class everyday with their binders and all necessary supplies and materials. They should not expect to make trips back and forth to lockers to get materials during class time or expect to borrow supplies from the teacher or classmates.
